

You can also shwitch to a focus on the print or its look on the environment with the slider on the bottom


Also you have toolbars on top, which will allow you to:


- Adjust the size of the wall

- Add Augmented Reality




You can upload your own images using the *Upload* option, or use image banks using the proper tabs.

Show the app.


Customers just need to point on the icon and the Link Reader app will run the video
